About the Role

The Aquarist Diver role assists the Curatorial Dive Supervisor, Senior Curatorial Diver and Aquarists with the delivery of consistently high standards of animal husbandry and exhibit cleanliness and presentation for guest satisfaction ensuring Health and Safety in relation to all dive operations and meeting all local and Merlin Dive standards for occupational diving.

Key responsibilities include;

- Actively fulfil maintenance dive duties following company diving safety procedures and performing tasks to schedule and to meet specified KPI's
- Ensure the highest possible standards of animal husbandry, exhibit presentation, technical operation and safety in daily operations of the SEA LIFE Sydney Aquarium
- Monitor all public display areas and achieve the objective of delivering a World Class guest experience
- Lead, train, develop and support dive team members in relation to all aspects of curatorial diving.
- Implement policies and procedures that maximise time management and efficiency of curatorial dive operations.
- Responsible for daily dive operations and the programmed maintenance and storage of diving related equipment.
- Maintenance and storage of documentation and databases for diving
- Demonstrate a high standard for animal care and professionalism.
- Assisting all other SEA LIFE Aquarium departments according to operational requirements.
- Work with the DSO to provide active participation in conservation dive projects.

The ideal candidate will possess high standards of professionalism and have experience within the aquarium industry, diver safety and following procedures. Your excellent interpersonal communication skills will give you the ability to lead by example and motivate the team to excel in their duties. A high work ethic and the ability to follow through with tasks whilst working in a changing environment is essential.
