We have an amazing opportunity to join our team at WILD LIFE Sydney Zoo as a Vet Nurse (Australian Fauna).

About the Role

This role will provide a range of services to the WILD LIFE Sydney Zoo Curatorial Department in the areas of animal health and record keeping with the aim of achieving and maintaining best practice industry standards. We have some flexibility with the days and shift length but ideally this candidate would work 6hr shifts Tuesday-Friday.

The ideal candidate for this role will need to meet the following selection criteria:

- Certificate IV in Veterinary Nursing with a minimum of 2 years full time equivalent work in a veterinary hospital or zoo setting.
- Experience in veterinary nursing practices, including surgical, anaesthesiology, medical, diagnostic and pathology laboratory procedures and maintenance of veterinary and medical supplies and equipment. Experience in critical care nursing of neonates will be highly favoured.
- Certificate III in Captive Animals or equivalent zoo industry experience would be beneficial.
- Demonstrated experience and knowledge of the role of animal records and information management.
- Demonstrated experience in the administration of records.
- Demonstrated interpersonal, verbal and written skills and ability to train and influence others.
- Demonstrated ability to be flexible, cope with frequent and unpredictable changes to daily routine and workloads, and to work at times under high pressure.
- Demonstrated ability to take initiative, work unsupervised, assess tasks and set priorities.
