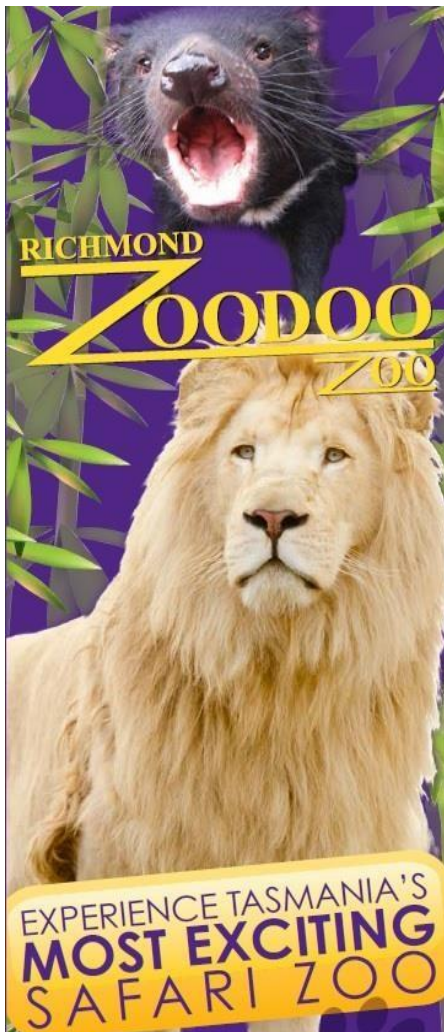


Position Vacant – Zoodoo Zoo Park Manager / Head Keeper

A position is now available for Park Manager. The position offers a unique, outdoor career working with a large variety of animals. The position would ideally begin in August 2018 which would include a 3 month trial period, followed by 12 month permanent contracts. Start dates can be negotiated.

This role includes the standard responsibilities of keepers & tour guides including to care for and maintain the animal populations at Zoodoo Zoo and to achieve customer satisfaction through interactive, educational and fun tours, presentations and encounters. Additional responsibilities of Park Manager would be to provide ongoing staff training, compliance checks on all aspects of keeper husbandry, monitor park stock levels, ongoing reporting to management and more.

This role is for those who have previous experience in wildlife park management roles.



To be considered for this role, applicants **MUST** demonstrate that they have the following;

- Minimum 5 years previous experience working with a variety of animals in a wildlife park / zoo setting.
- Minimum 2 years previous experience in head keeper / park management role.
- Relevant qualifications i.e Cert III captive Animal Management, Zoology etc
- Previous experience with tour guiding / customer interaction
- Outgoing personality to provide loud & fun tours.
- Workplace references to verify work ethic and character
- Well-developed communication and teamwork skills
- Broad knowledge of a range of animal species and handling techniques, including ability to work with large animals.
- High level of physical fitness and strength
- Mature & approachable personality
- Current unrestricted full manual car drivers licence
- Flexibility to work weekends, public holidays & school holidays.

Additional points that may aid a successful application, but are not essential;

- Ability to adequately handle machinery such as electric tools, chainsaws, lawn mowers, tractors etc
 - Previous experience driving large vehicles / passenger vehicles
 - Firearms licence, First Aid Training, OH&S training
- Previous experience with big cats, primates, reptiles
 - Basic general repair / maintenance skills
